Contest Overview

The AMERIND Risk Safety Poster Contest is coming up. We encourage a Housing Authority or TDHE to sponsor a local Poster Contest for children in grades K-3, 4-6, and 7-8. Contestants should submit a poster that promotes any safety issue (examples: fire, distracted driving, home fire escape plan, how to call 9-1-1, etc.) You could win \$1,000!

Checklist for Housing Authorities:

- Conduct local poster contest BEFORE the 2019 first quarter regional meeting.
- Submit only the 1st place poster from each age category.
- DO NOT send posters to AMERIND! All posters must be judged at the regional level first. Posters submitted to AMERIND Risk by individual housing authorities will not be accepted.

Note to Regional Housing Associations

- Posters from members of AMERIND Risk’s nine regions are eligible to participate.
- AMERIND Risk Member housing entities are to submit their 1st place winners to the regional housing association.
- Each Region submits the 1st place winners from each category to AMERIND Risk postmarked no later than March 31, 2019.
- The national on-line judging will be conducted April 2019 at www.AMERINDRisk.org .

Safety Poster Official Rules

- Entry form must be filled out completely.
- Illustrate a “safety” theme.
- Children in Kindergarten through the 8th grade are eligible to participate. Only one entry per child.
- Category grades: K-3, 4-6, 7-8
- All entries must be original and created by the child using crayons, markers, colored pencil or paint.
- Posters must be drawn horizontally on 8.5” x 11” paper.
