Update on HUD Grants

- FY 2018 ICDBG Initial application period expired January 7th during government shutdown
 - HUD re-opened the application period for 30 days, deadline was March 20th
 - o Past practice awards announced 3-4 months after deadline (would be June/July)
- FY 2018 \$100 Million Competitive Grant Application
 - Federal register notice on March 18 related to Paperwork Reduction Act requirements (60-day comment period)
 - o Precursor to NOFA being released, so earliest NOFA could come out in 5/18/2019
 - o HUD considering awarding FY18 and FY19 amounts together (\$200 million total)
- FY 2019 ICDBG (\$65M) and FY 2019 Competitive \$100 M timeline TBD

NAIHC News:

- Pathways Home trainings throughout 2018, more to come in 2019
 - Curriculum updated in Spring 2018
 - Over 1,000 booklets were printed and made available
 - New print runs still occurring, and materials may be available upon request
 - Fall trainings under a Wells Fargo grant included South Dakota, Alaska, New Mexico,
 Maine.
 - o 2019 trainings in South Carolina in September; Oklahoma in October
 - Travel scholarships likely available
 - Following up at 6- and 12-month intervals with trainees to gauge impact
- Highlighting Leadership Institute 20th Anniversary throughout 2019
 - Providing updates on where PIHM certificate holders are now
 - Implementing LI classes through online training (only 1 or 2 courses in 2019)
 - Signed contract with eLearning vendor in January
 - 1st Course development underway

 Hope to roll out the first training, Indian Housing Management, around the Annual Convention

 - o 2 in May

Legislative Updates:

- New 116th Congress in session:
 - o Denny Heck expected to be new House lead for NAHASDA Reauthorization
 - NAIHC working with staff to determine full scope of bill, identify problem issues with new House majority
 - HUD-VASH introduced in Senate
 - Reported out by Indian Affairs Committee
 - Working to identify any issues with House before full Senate passage
 - Close to passing in 2018, but pulled from House calendar at last minute, due to objection on no expiration date for program
 - o FY 2020 President's Budget:

- President's budget would again cut most federal programs that impact tribal housing
- Would cut IHBG to \$600 M, but not likely Congress will pass
- Overall, Congress has been better on Indian Housing funding-wise, just need HUD to get money out to tribes
